Plumbing works are required to be inspected by Council. Principal Certifying Authorities (PCA) are not authorised to inspect plumbing works. <u>NOTE</u>: Where a development application is required, fees should be paid upon lodgement of such application. It is the responsibility of the applicant/owner when making an application for a service to ensure that it is required and that the fees have not already been paid.
